Research Analysis

SB 1439 modifies the method of selecting applicants for motor license agents. The measure requires that in counties with a population of more than 30,000, the operation of a motor license agency be the primary source of income for the agent. The measure allows the Tax Commission to determine the number of motor license agents necessary to carry out the provisions of the Motor Vehicle License and Registration Act.
