Research Analysis

The CS for SB 148 provides that a change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or state identification card submitted by a registered voter will also serve as a change of address for voting purposes if the new address is in the same county, unless the registrant states the change is not for voter registration purposes. If the new address is in another county, the voter will be sent instructions for registering to vote at the new address.

Provisions of the measure are not anticipated to impact agency or state revenues, as changes of address are handled at the county level- however, counties may incur costs associated with the mailings required. The State Election Board does not retain data on how many individuals may require mailings.
