Research Analysis

SB 148 provides that a change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or state identification card submitted by a registered voter will also serve as a change of address for voting purposes if the new address is in the same county, unless the registrant states the change is not for voter registration purposes. If the new address is in another county, the voter will be sent instructions for registering to vote at the new address. The bill also provides that the Department of Public Safety will receive \$0.50 for each paper voter registration application taken by its employees and \$0.05 for each voter registration application or change of address sent electronically to the State Election Board.
