Research Analysis

SB 1481 modifies the reporting methods within the Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act. The measure requires that persons selling scrap metal to a dealer provide a photo identification issued by the United States government or state issued identification. The measure prohibits the sale or purchase of copper wire that is four gauge or larger unless sold by an exempted-seller. The measure prohibits a scrap metal dealer from providing payment for a vehicle until the certificate of ownership has been submitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or a motor license agent and the vehicle is determined not to be stolen.
