Research Analysis

SB 1513 provides that no more than three registered apprentice electricians may work under the supervision of a single journeyman or contractor. The measure also exempts from the definition of *electrical work* any work related to or facilitating to the construction, installation or maintenance of all or part of an electrical system that does not involve actual work with specific components listed in the statutory definition. Finally, the bill exempts from the Electrical License Act alarm and locksmiths, as well as low voltage providers working on Class 2 and Class 3 circuits.
