Research Analysis

SB 1520 changes position requirements for Administrator of the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, to allow two years' experience with managerial responsibility or as a liquefied petroleum gas safety enforcement officer. The measure also doubles the maximum fine for a violation of the act, from \$500 to \$1000, removes an exemption from permit fees for trucks transporting liquefied petroleum gas out of the state, and clarifies and updates statutory language.
