Research Analysis

SB 1529 requires new, non-residential elevators to be inspected before operation begins. The bill allows an owner, operator or installer of a new residential elevator to request a voluntary inspection for compliance with the provisions of the Elevator Safety Act without becoming subject to any additional responsibilities under the act. The measure also authorizes elevator inspection by a third-party inspector.
