**Research Analysis**

SB 153 removes the requirement that the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission use monies collected from entrance or day-use charges for capital improvements. The measure also provides that the commission may establish other kinds of passes in addition to or in place of an annual pass as currently required.
