SB 1538 sets the expiration date of building and construction inspector licenses to the last day in the birth month of the licensee. The measure also changes the method for determining whether a municipality is under population 10,000, and thus exempt from the Oklahoma Inspectors Act, by using data from the U.S. Census Bureau.
