**Research Analysis**

SB 1548 directs DHS to recommend technological enhancements to support the state's education and training programs for recipients of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program. The measure also requires the department to explore opportunities for the state to contract with additional community-based entities to provide services to education and training enrollees in the TANF and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance programs.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1548 directs, contingent upon available funding, to explore and recommend technological advancements necessary to support the state's education and training programs for TANF recipients.
