**Research Analysis**

SB 155 requires a building and construction inspector with a provisional license to be under the supervision of a licensed mentor, and reduces the time period of the provisional license from 2 years to 6 months. The measure also removes the definition of *report writer*.

The bill empowers the Oklahoma Inspector Examiners Committee to fund and develop a program to enable mid-sized political subdivisions to share building and construction inspectors.
