Engrossed SB1566 authorizes the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, Oklahoma Historical Society, State Department of Education and Oklahoma Department of Transportation to work together to develop educational programs and materials for schools that promote Oklahoma historical sites, tourism and heritage preservation. These selected agencies may use agency funds and solicit private funding and donations to implement projects.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure concerns the Heritage Preservation Revolving Fund and widens the language for usage. The bill stipulates that any project would be subject to the availability of funds and could be used by the Oklahoma Recreation and Tourism Department (OTRD) if the agency chose to participate. Therefore, as written, there is a \$0 fiscal impact. However, if the OTRD did choose to opt in, there would be an impact. See other considerations.

Depending on the physical size, number of pages, research costs, and material acquisition, OTRD estimates the production costs in the range of \$80,000 to \$110,000. The actual printing costs would depend on the physical size, number of pages, paper quality, any printing treatments and quantity printed.
