**Research Analysis**

Floor Amendment 1 restores title. The amendment creates the Leave of Last Resort Bank to be administered by the Human Capital Management Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. The amendment requires the division to designate an employee to serve as the shared leave liaison to coordinate with state agencies and employees wishing to utilize the leave bank. The leave bank will be funded by voluntary donations of annual and sick leave from employees retiring from or leaving state service.

**Fiscal Analysis**

FA1 to SB 1581, modifies the shared leave provisions for state employees. Officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) anticipate the ability to absorb within their existing budget any efforts or costs associated with implementing the provisions of SB 1581 as amended by FA1. FA1 eliminates the fiscal impact from previous versions of the measure.
