**Fiscal Analysis**

FA2 to SB166 adds certain individuals, including peace officers and first responders fallen in performance of their duties, to those individuals for whom costs associated with highway and bridge namings are to be paid for by the state, as opposed to the group sponsoring or requesting the sign. As this amendment does not name any individuals to whom this provision would apply, there is no immediate impact to state revenues. Estimated cost to the Department for such signage totals between \$1,000 and \$2,000 per location depending on the class of highway.
