Research Analysis

SB 17 creates the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial Revolving Fund for use by the Oklahoma Historical Society. Funds are to be used for the purpose of commemorating the centennial of the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot. The measure further transfers funds in the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation Revolving Fund to the new fund being created.

Finally, the bill repeals sections of law in Title 74, Chapter 102 – The 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation Design Committee, including:

- § 8201.1. The 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation Design Committee
- § 8201.2. The 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation Revolving Fund
- § 8203. Raising Monies for Purposes Set Forth in the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Reconciliation Act
- § 8204. Property Acquisition for the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation -Transfer of Society's Duties
- § 8205. Certification of Surviving Residents of Tulsa Race Riots
