**Research Analysis**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> CCR to SB 185 requires each member of the Pardon and Parole Board to complete annual training based on guidance from organizations that provide training and technical assistance related to the probation and parole process. The annual training curriculum is to include identifying, understanding and targeting criminogenic needs, the principles of effective intervention, core correctional practices and how to support and encourage offender behavior change. The measure also modifies the qualifications to be appointed to the Pardon and Parole Board.
