Research Analysis

The measure modifies the a portion of the Open Records Act by stating that the only acceptable excuse for delaying reasonable access to a records request can be attributable to the amount of time required for preparing the requested documents and to avoid excessive disruptions of the public body's essential functions. The measure also states that under no circumstance can a production of a current request for records be unreasonably delayed until after completion of a prior records request that will take much longer than the current request.
