**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to SB 207 provides that the chief medical examiner is to release copies of the full and complete report of the facts developed by an autopsy together with the findings of the person making the report to the public in the most expedient manner available. The report must be furnished to law enforcement, family and insurance company. The measure also requires certain information to be contained within the report. The measure allows a report to be withheld from the public under certain circumstances.
