**Research Analysis**

The bill removes the average daily membership figure from the exemption provided for the prohibition of familial relations being eligible to be a candidate for or serve on a board of education. Additionally, it adds an exemption from the prohibition if a person is employed as a teacher by the school district and is related to a board member within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity.
