SB 211 provides that sales of alcoholic beverages on Sundays by retail spirits licensees shall be unlawful in any county of this state unless approved by a majority of the registered voters of the county voting thereon at a special election called by the board of county commissioners. Upon approval, sales may occur on Sundays between the hours of noon and midnight.
