**Research Analysis**

SB 227 allows a service member to terminate or suspend certain services, including from a telecommunications or Internet service provider, a health club, a health spa, or television service provider without fee, penalty, loss of deposit or other additional cost. The service member must provide proof of official orders showing that the service member has been called into active service. The services may be reinstated later.
