**Research Analysis**

The bill removes the age limitation from subsection a of the definition for *assisted outpatient* as used in Title 43A. It further modifies the definition by including persons being discharged from a residential placement by the Office of Juvenile Affairs and juveniles who are on a specialized treatment plan for the treatment of mental illness in a secure juvenile facility or placement in a specialized residential program for juveniles.
