Research Analysis

SB 233 clarifies the limit on the leave of absence available to employees of the state or a political subdivision who are also members of the National Guard or a reserve component of any branch. Current law allows these employees, when called into active service, to take a leave of absence and receive their full regular pay for the first 30 calendar days or first 30 regularly scheduled days, without loss of status or seniority. This measure provides for a limit of 240 hours.
