Research Analysis

SB 24 allows an acting agent of an employer or an employer of a person who operates a commercial, company-owned or personal motor vehicle during the course of business in the course of his or her employment with the employer to be notified when the driving record of the employee reflects a traffic conviction or an administrative action has been taken by the Department of Public Safety which alters the status of the commercial driving privilege of the employee. For each driving record furnished electronically, the Department is to collect \$25, with \$18 deposited to the General Revenue Fund, \$5 deposited in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund, and \$2 to be retained by the Department for development and maintenance of the electronic notification system.

Fiscal Analysis

The ENGR version of SB 24 upon review by DPS is considered a revenue neutral impact to the state. The fee listed in the bill to DPS (\$5.00) is already being assessed. The only change will be the \$2.00 increase charged to business owners that will go to Oklahoma Interactive (private company) for the re-design of the Driver Status Notification System (DSNS).

The bill also opens the program up for businesses that have drivers who operate non-commercial vehicles during the course of business. This could increase the total amount of revenue DPS receives for the program; however this increase is contingent upon how many businesses opt in to use the program.
