SB 249 provides a definition of “domestic sex trafficking of minors” within the criminal statutes. “Domestic sex trafficking of minors” means a commercial sex act that is induced by force, fraud or coercion, or in which the person induced to perform such an act has not attained eighteen (18) years of age.

Fiscal Analysis

The ENGR version of SB 249 which adds the term and definition of domestic sex trafficking of minors to the list of those crimes which are punishable by a felony and imprisonment/fine of not more than \$100,000. This could increase incarceration rates but the exact number would be dependent upon how many are convicted of the crime. The daily average incarceration rate is \$52.24.
