**Research Analysis**

SB 252 modifies the definition of “victims impact panel” to mean a program conducted by a non-profit corporation registered with the Secretary of State solely for the purpose of operating a victims impact panel. The measure also allows the panel to include presentations on the operation of a motor vehicle while using an electronic communication device. The measure requires the provider of the victims impact panel to provide certain information to the Administrative Office of the Courts annually.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The ENGR version of SB 252 removes two fee minimums for (1) a defendant’s participation in the impact panel and (2) persons attending the panel. No fiscal impact for the state.
