**Fiscal Analysis**

The ENGR version of SB 275 allows a court to award reasonable expenses (attorney fees, expert witness fees, court costs and cost and compensation for lost income) to a citizen who is adversely affected by a person, municipality, agency or political subdivision. This could require a loss to some state agencies, but this is dependent upon how many cases are lost and what the awards would be.
