SB 287 authorizes the Corporation Commission and the Department of Environmental Quality to seek delegation from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to administer programs regulating oil and gas discharges into the state's water bodies.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, per the Corporation Commission (OCC), as written, would have \$0 anticipated impact to the state. SB 287 authorizes the Corporation Commission and the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), to administer within their respective jurisdictions, any and all programs regulating oil and gas discharges into the waters of the state. The measure is not expected to have a substantial fiscal impact on the DEQ. Additionally, the DEQ currently has delegation from the EPA for discharges to waters that are subject to DEQ's jurisdiction.
