Research Analysis

The measure authorizes the Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Department of Human Services and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission to require agency employees who are in positions to review certain tax information and data to supply all information necessary to be subjected to a criminal history search conducted by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Fiscal Analysis

The ENGR version of SB 292 authorizes the Tax Commission, Dept. of Human Services, and the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission to require all employees in positions that have access to federal tax information to be subjected to a national criminal history check. Upon review by OSBI, there is no appreciable impact upon their workload as a result of this measure. There is no fiscal impact.
