Research Analysis

The bill pertains to signage that must be posted in certain facilities or clinics where abortions are performed. It adds the following language to the current signage:

There are public and private agencies willing and able to help you carry your child to term, have a healthy pregnancy and a healthy baby and assist you and your child after your child is born, whether you choose to keep your child or place him or her for adoption. The State of Oklahoma strongly encourages you to contact them if you are pregnant.

The bill removes a provision contained within the Humanity of the Unborn Child Act that required the posting of certain signage within public restrooms and directs the State Department of Health to use its official, online social media platforms to promote the website created within the Act.
