Research Analysis

The measure requires churches that temporarily accommodate overnight visitors to have a hard-wired stand-alone fire and smoke alarm in the area of the overnight accommodations as well as illuminated exit signs. Additionally, the measure requires a means of a way out of the building free of obstructions in case of a fire emergency.

Impact:

Finally, the measure changes the definition of *temporary* from meaning at least 7 consecutive days lasting no more than 40 days to no more than 75 days in a calendar year.
