**Research Analysis**

SB 325 creates a \$100 fee for persons convicted in this state, who make a request for transfer to another state pursuant to the Interstate Compact.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS version of SB 325 allows DOC to assess a \$100 fee for each transfer application received. The fee will be charged to the offender and the Director of DOC or his/her designee can waive the fee if it is determined the fee creates an undue financial burden. The fee revenue will be utilized to support the staff and other related costs for DOC transfers.

Using data provided by DOC:

From 10/10/2015 to 10/11/2016 DOC processed 1,709 outgoing applications (1,632 probation, 77 parole). If the upcoming year's numbers are similar, if 75% of application fees are paid, DOC will receive  $1,282 \times \$100 = \$128,200$  in revenue to run the program.
