Research Analysis

The measure directs the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to combine the following non-mandatory construction and property services into one program:

- The Roof Asset Management Program (RAMP);
- The On-Call Consultants Program;
- The Testing Program; and
- The Land Surveying Program.

The program will be managed by OMES. The measure sets a ceiling of \$50,000 on any roofing contract entered into on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision by the office of OMES through the new program.

Fiscal Analysis

According to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, implementation of the measure will result in a loss of \$274,000 due to loss of fees the agency collects from projects that would exceed the proposed cap. Such a loss will likely result in discontinuation of the program.
