Research Analysis

The measure authorizes the secretary of the county election board in counties with 25,000 or more registered voters, or with an area greater than 1,500 square miles, to designate more than one location as an in-person absentee polling place for an election with the approval of the Secretary of the state Election Board. Current law authorizes this only to counties with more than 100,000 voters.

Fiscal Analysis

The State Election Board would reimburse for a two-member Absentee Voting Board for each day of early voting at the alternate site during statewide elections, at a cost of \$174 per day or \$522 total for each county. The agency would also provide mileage reimbursement, if applicable.
