SB 35 allows a person 21 years of age or older who is active military or a member of the Reserve or National Guard to carry a handgun without a license.

Fiscal Analysis

The ENGR version of SB 35 upon review by the OSBI has been determined to have "some negative impact upon our revolving fund revenue as a result of SB 35 but it is difficult to assess with any degree of precision. About 13.6% of SDA handgun license applicants answer yes to the application question 'Are you currently or have you previously served in the U.S. Military?' OSBI does not have data on how many are active military, active reservists, and active National Guard members. Assuming 5% of all applicants are active military the fiscal impact would be approximately \$300,000 less in annual revolving fund revenue based upon our current year projected SDA total revenue of \$6.38M."
