Engrossed SB353 establishes a sale tax exemption for sales of goods and services to and by the National Guard Association of Oklahoma.

Fiscal Analysis

From the Tax Commission:

The measure proposes to amend 68 O. S. § 1357 by exempting from the sales tax levy, sales of tangible personal property or services to or by an association which is exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3) and which is known as the National Guard Association of Oklahoma.

Information received from the Association indicates that it does not presently make any sales of tangible personal property or taxable services but did remit sales tax in the amount of \$8,700 on its purchases for FY 16.

The measure has an effective date of August 25, 2017². Application of annual inflation rate adjustments of 2.2% yields an estimated decrease in state sales tax collections for FY 18 of \$6,815³ and \$9,287 for FY 19.
