**Research Analysis**

SB 371 prohibits any insurance agent or company to knowingly renew a fire insurance policy on any risk located in a rural fire protection district, or in an area protected by a rural fire department, at a reduced rate without first obtaining evidence that current dues or subscription payments due to the district or department have been paid. Current law is that the insurance agent or company may not *rewrite* such a fire insurance policy.
