**Research Analysis**

SB 411 authorizes the sale and sampling of beer at licensed breweries between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. The measure allows retail spirit license holders to sell alcoholic beverages between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and midnight. The measure allows retail wine and retail beer license holders to sell beer or wine between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m.
