Research Analysis

The measure modifies the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma by clarifying that the *last day of pre-retirement employment* includes those who are on paid leave; currently, this is defined as the last day that an employee is physically present on the job.

Additionally, the measure modifies post-retirement earnings limitations for certain retired teachers. For a period of three years beginning July 1, 2017, the measure allows teachers who have retired as active teachers, have been receiving benefits for at least one year, and have not been employed by any public school during that period to return to work with no limitations on earnings. Teachers who have returned during this period will not be subject to earning limitations at the end of the three-year period.
