The measure creates the Oklahoma Public and Private Facilities and Infrastructure Act. The act creates a framework that would allow a governmental entity to contract with a private entity to finance, maintain, improve, equip, modify, repair or operate a qualifying project.

Fiscal Analysis

The Oklahoma Public and Private Facilities and Infrastructure Act contains provisions for contracting and procurement between public and private entities and authorizes the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to charge certain fees to offset program operating expenses, though these fees are not specified in the measure. The CS exempts the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority from the act. OMES does not currently have any specific cost data with which to assess potential impact but will continue to examine the issue as new information becomes available.
