Research Analysis

SB 531 adds a definition for *integrated security system* to the Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Act and provides that a licensee under the act not be required to obtain multiple licenses to install, repair or modify any component of an integrated security system. The measure also authorizes the Department of Labor to regulate advancements in technology that apply to the alarm, locksmith and fire sprinkler industry, and updates statutory language.
