Engrossed SB559 modifies a provision that prohibits retaliation by an employer of an employee that is subjected to wage garnishment. The measure establishes a blanket prohibition against discharge of any employee that is subjected to wage garnishment due to a money judgment arising from a debt, consumer credit sale, consumer lease or consumer loan.
