Research Analysis

SB 588 directs the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to transfer the Forest Heritage Center in Beavers Bend State Park to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure addresses the transfer of the Forest Heritage Center from the Oklahoma Department of Recreation and Tourism (ODRT) to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forest (ODAFF).

The measure's impact, per the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Food and the Oklahoma Department of Recreation and Tourism is estimated to be negligible.

Per the Oklahoma Department of Recreation and Tourism, the Forest Heritage Center is a 20,000 square foot structure initially purchased in 1981 for \$37,500 and has had \$900,000 in capital improvements. The agency estimates the property worth approximately \$937,500.
