**Fiscal Analysis**

The FA1 on SB 6:

- Eliminates SDA handgun licensing with a few exceptions. According to OSBI, “the fiscal impact is significant. The loss of annual recurring OSBI revolving fund revenue is estimated to be as much as \$6 million which is about 15-18% of our current operations budget.”
- Specifies a misdemeanor charge as well as a penalty fine of \$250 for the crime of any person unlawfully present in the United States to have possession of a firearm.
- Establishes a misdemeanor charge as well as a penalty fine of not more than \$100 for the crime of a person failing or refusing to identify the fact that the person is in actual possession of a firearm to a law enforcement officer.
