**Research Analysis**

The CCR for SB 615 allows hunting of feral swine on private property, without a license, at night, with a vehicle and spotlight, while using night-vision equipment. The measure also allows for removal of feral swine on public property in accordance with the administrative rules of the Wildlife Department and repeals the special permit that is required for private property owners to kill/attempt to kill depredating feral swing during deer gun and primitive firearm season. The measure clarifies residency status of minors in joint custody.
