**Research Analysis**

The measure modifies the Oklahoma Transportation Network Company Services Act. The bill clarifies that a Transportation Network Company (TNC) that voluntarily elects to require TNC drivers to display a company logo while in operation to identify the vehicle and driver will not change the contractual relationship between the driver and the company or create an employer/employee relationship where one is not intended to exist.
