SB 635 creates nonresident youth hunting licenses for deer gun season, deer archery season, and deer primitive firearm season.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as written per the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC), has a varied impact. If only new hunters are added, and there is no loss of nonresident youth that typically purchase the \$280 deer licenses, the fiscal impact would be negligible. However, if all nonresident youth hunters purchase the new \$30 doe license in lieu of the \$280 license, there would be a negative annual fiscal impact of up to \$104,750 to the agency.
