## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, as written per the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC), has a varied impact. If only new hunters are added, and there is no loss of nonresident youth that typically purchase the \$280 deer licenses, the fiscal impact would be negligible. However, if all nonresident youth hunters purchase the new \$30 doe license in lieu of the \$280 license, there would be a negative annual fiscal impact of up to \$104,750 to the agency.
