**Research Analysis**

SB 646 allows beer distributors to hold an interim license. The measure also provides that any license issued by the ABLE Commission may be relied upon by other licensees as a valid license, and no other licensee has any obligation to independently determine the validity of such license or be held liable solely as a consequence of another licensee's failure to maintain a valid license.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The ENGR version of SB 646 upon review by the ABLE Commission is determined to have a revenue neutral impact on the agency. Interim licenses cost the same amounts as other ABLE licenses. In order for the agency to handle the state question changes, these licenses will allow beer distributors to continue operations without delays.
