**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to SB 650 allows a person convicted of a non-violent offense to seek an expungement if the person has not had a separate misdemeanor conviction within 7 years following the completion of sentence. The measure allows a person who has been convicted of not more than two non-violent felony offenses to seek an expungement if the person has not been convicted of any other felony or misdemeanor within ten years of the date following the completion of the execution of the sentence.
